Intercession for persecuted Iranian believers, led by persecuted Iranian believers.




SARA:

"God gave His peace to me while I was in prison... I pray He would protect the minds and bodies of those now in prison for His Name."

PRAYER

Pray that as believers in Iran face the harsh reality of prison, God would protect them - mind, body and spirit. Pray for His "peace that passes understanding" to take root in them.



MORAD:

"Iranians are not just praying to be freed from persecution. We are praying for the boldness to speak about Jesus, even while we suffer."

PRAYER

Pray that all Christians in Iran, both new and mature believers, will have boldness to share the Gospel whatever their circumstances, and that God would perform His wonders through them, drawing many to Himself.



LADAN:

God brought Scriptures to my mind in my cell to build up my faith. I'm praying that God would encourage and comfort His people amid persecution."

PRAYER

Pray that God would bring His Word to the minds of persecuted believers, to encourage them in the midst of interrogations, periods of solitary confinement, or during court hearings, as He did for Ladan.



FARSHID:

"I spent 1,820 days in prison. On each of those days, I thought about freedom...

Now, I pray regularly that God would soften the hearts of Iran's leaders."

PRAYER

Pray that Iran's leaders would be moved by the Spirit to repent. Pray that, as a result, all Iranians would experience a new season of freedom from oppression, including freedom to worship Jesus.
